



USS Hampton Scholarship

For Crewmembers and Dependents of USS HAMPTON (SSN 767)

The USS Hampton Scholarship was established by the commissioning committee of USS HAMPTON (SSN 767) in 1996 to be awarded to the crewmembers and dependents of USS HAMPTON (SSN 767) for further education. This independent scholarship is administered by the Dolphin Scholarship Foundation. A total of two \$1500 scholarships may be awarded in an academic year.

SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY

The USS Hampton Scholarship shall be awarded to current or former crewmembers of USS HAMPTON (SSN 767), or the spouse, child or stepchild of a crewmember who has served a minimum of two years aboard USS HAMPTON (SSN 767).

Summary of Student Eligibility

- High school senior or college student
- Child or stepchild of crewmember or former crewmember of USS HAMPTON (SSN 767)
- Unmarried on March 15
- Under age 24 on March 15
- Scholar must intend to or currently be enrolled full-time at an accredited 2 or 4-year college/university and working toward an Associate's or Bachelor's degree **OR** be working toward trade/vocational certification.

Summary of Crewmember or Spouse Eligibility

- High school graduate
- Current or former crewmember or Spouse of crewmember or former crewmember of the USS Hampton (SSN 767)
- Crewmember or Spouse must intend to or currently be enrolled full-time or part-time at an accredited 2 or 4-year college/university and working toward an Associate's or Bachelor's degree **OR** be working toward trade/vocational certification.

The deadline for the application and all supporting documents is March 15 of application year.

Selection of recipients for the USS HAMPTON SCHOLARSHIP shall be separate from and non-competitive with applicants for the Dolphin Scholarship. Applicants for the HAMPTON SCHOLARSHIP may also apply for the Dolphin Scholarship, providing all DSF eligibility criteria are met.
