# DSF Announces USS Scorpion (SSN 589) Scholarship Endowment

Approached in late 2021 by an anonymous donor, DSF was challenged to fulfill a USS Scorpion Scholarship Endowment to memorialize the 99 officers and crew members who were lost on May 22, 1968 when she went down on her way home to Norfolk, VA. Endowed scholarships are funded to a level that allows the scholarship to be drawn from invested funds, thus having the ability to be granted in perpetuity, a fitting tribute to these Sailors who serve on Eternal Patrol.

The donor provided a lead gift and matched donations up to half the scholarship endowment amount while family, friends, colleagues, and submarine supporters near and far made memorial donations and shared memories of the men aboard. A list of supporters can be found on page 8.

# From the Desk of the Executive Director

I would like to thank all of our volunteers, spouse groups, and both individual and corporate supporters for making 2023 a banner year for DSF. Your loyal support is the driving force behind the positive impact that the foundation is able to make in the lives of members of the submarine community and their families.

The following are some highlights of what DSF was able to achieve in 2023, with your help:

Beginning in August 2023, DSF scholarship award amounts for scholars attending 2 and 4 year universities and trade/vocational institutions increased between 14 and 24 percent.

The establishment of the USS Scorpion (SSN 589) Scholarship marked the 58th Dolphin Scholarship endowed in perpetuity which reduces the foundation's unmet funding need to sustain 113 Dolphin Scholarships to 49 percent. Also, the establishment of the USS Montana (SSN 794) Scholarship marks the 10th DSF administered scholarship to benefit the crewmembers of specific submarines and their dependents.

Thanks to our corporate sponsors and participants for our annual Groton and Virginia Beach golf tournament fundraisers, over \$36,000 in net proceeds were raised for the Dolphin Scholarship Program.

Submarine Spouse Groups raised a combined total of \$125,326.00 for Dolphin Scholarships.

The 2023 End of Year fundraising campaign surpassed its targeted goal of \$20,000 by 34 percent with over \$26,800 raised for Dolphin Scholarships.

Thank you again for believing in the DSF mission of enhancing the quality of life and human potential of the sons, daughters, and spouses of U.S. Navy submariners through education. Please give yourself a round of applause because none of this would be possible without your support. Hooyah Submarine Force!!

# Scholarship Application FAQs

- Can I get a scholarship for a Master's or Doctorate Program?
  - No. Scholarships are only available for those pursuing their first associates/bachelors/trade school certification.
- My sponsor did 5 years of Active-Duty time and 6 years in the Reserves, am I eligible?
  - No, only active-duty time counts towards the minimum 6 year of Submarine Service or 8 year of Submarine Support Service requirement.
- My grandfather was in the Submarine Force, can I apply?
  - Currently, the only scholarship available to grandchildren is for those sponsors who served on USS Nautilus (SSN 571/SS 168) or Historic Ship Nautilus.
- I'm an active-duty Sailor. Can I apply?
  - Scholarships for active-duty Sailors are limited to crew members who have served on the following submarines -USS Hampton, USS Colorado, USS Indiana, USS Delaware, USS Oregon, and USS Washington. These scholarships are not renewable and vary in award amount.
- I am unable to pursue my degree fulltime due to other commitments. Can I still receive a scholarship?
  - Only spouses are eligible to pursue part-time coursework. They must maintain a minimum course load of 12 credit hours per semester.
- My older sibling applied for a scholarship. Do I need to submit all the required eligibility information?
  - Yes, DSF does not maintain eligibility records from year to year.

- I plan on using the post 9/11 GI Bill, can I still receive a Dolphin Scholarship?
  - Dolphin Scholarships are the payer of last resort. If there is no financial need, the scholarship will not be issued.
- Who completes the application?
  - When starting the application, the name and email of the student should be used, not the sponsor.
- When does my sponsor's submarine service start?
  - Enlisted time starts the day they class up in BESS. Officer and nuclear trained enlisted time starts the first day of Prototype.
- How do I find my sponsors history of duty assignments?
  - The history of duty assignments can be found in the service members Electronic Service Record, or by contacting Navy Personnel Command to request a NAVPERS 1070/605 or Officer Data Card. # FAQs Continued

- When should I send in my transcript?
  - Transcripts are accepted after Fall semester grades have been posted.
- I'm not ready to go to college. Can I apply when I'm older?
  - Yes, child applicants must be under the age of 24 on March 15th of their application year.
- How do I receive my scholarship?
  - Funds are mailed directly to your school biannually on August 1 and December 1.




